Dear Parents / Family / Whānau

Thank you for your understanding as we seek to deal with the impact of COVID-19 on our students and staff. School has been a different place without our seniors and we very much look forward to having our Year 11, 12 and 13 students returning to school on Monday.

We have been using attendance data for both students and staff to predict a likely scenario for next week, taking into account all of those who will still be impacted by their 10 days of isolation. The data is telling us that we will be in the same relative position next week regarding our staffing as we have been this week, therefore we will need to consider two possible scenarios:

Scenario 1: We will roster home our Year 11 students on Wednesday 9th March
We will roster home our Year 12 students on Thursday 10th March
We will roster home our Year 13 students on Friday 11th March

Scenario 2: We will roster home all of our senior students (Year 11, 12 and 13 students) for three days beginning on Wednesday 9th March

My plan is to wait until Monday afternoon so I can access our most recent attendance data before deciding which scenario to choose. My preference at this stage is Scenario 1, but this will be contingent upon the latest data.
