

ŌTŪMOETAI COLLEGE ENROLMENT SCHEME

Ōtūmoetai College operates an enrolment scheme to avoid overcrowding and to enable the Ministry of Education to make best use of the current network of schools.

The optimum roll will be 1800.

Under the legislation:

1. The geographic area as described below is the school's home zone:

The home zone of the College will include the Otumoetai Peninsula to the Matua shore in the north; to the Chapel Street bridge and the Kopurererua (Judea) Stream in the east; including Cambridge Road and its side roads to State Highway 29 in the south; to the west (Bethlehem, Minden, Te Puna, Whakamarama, Omokoroa) to the Waipapa River.

All students living in the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school at any time.

2. The school operates the following approved special programme:

Special Needs (IHC) Unit

Students who live within the school's home zone and meet the criteria for enrolment in the above special programme will be enrolled separately.

3. Out of Zone Enrolments:

Applications for out of zone enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- First Priority Nil
- **Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- Third Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- Fourth Priority will be given to applicants who are children of board employees.
- **Fifth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989.
